### Day 1

#### Arrival - Shanghai

**Transfer via:** *International Flight , arranged on your own*

**Meals:** Welcome dinner

**Accommodation:** Sunrise on The Bund, Standard Room

A local tour guide will greet you at the airport exit and transfer you in a comfortable vehicle to your downtown hotel. The rest of the day is yours to relax or explore this great city on your own.

Enjoy a Welcome dinner tonight!

### Day 2

#### Shanghai

**Meals:** Breakfast, lunch

**Accommodation:** Sunrise on The Bund, Standard Room

Full day tour to visit the old part of Shanghai, Yu Garden (closed on Monday, except holidays) and Yuyuan Market.

Drive about 65km away from the city of Shanghai, visit FengJing Old Town, this old water town was built in Yuan Dynasty around 1500 years ago. Nowadays, this town still remains its old outlook with traditional style houses, bridges, streets and lots of canals vertically and horizontally laid in the town.



### Day 3

## Shanghai - Beijing

**Transfer via:** High speed G train (Duration: about 5-6 hours), Second Class Seat

**Meals:** Breakfast

**Accommodation:** Beijing Novotel Peace Hotel, Deluxe Room

Private transfer from Hotel to station (Shanghai). After arrival, private transfer from Station to Hotel (Beijing).

### Day 4

## Beijing

**Meals:** Breakfast, A la carte lunch

**Accommodation:** Beijing Novotel Peace Hotel, Deluxe Room

After breakfast, drive about two hours to visit the less crowded Mutianyu section of the Great Wall. Here, you can take a cable car up and do some moderate hiking on the wall to enjoy the majestic scenery.

**Accommodation:** Grand Noble Hotel Xian, Nobel Club Floor Room

This morning Play Taichi at Temple of Heaven and then visit Temple of Heaven.

Transfer to the station for your train to Xian. After arrival, you will be met and transferred to the hotel.

Terracotta Army Excursion, one of the most significant archeological finds of the 20th century and has been registered in the list of UNESCO World Heritage Site.. Followed by a visit to the Ancient City Walls.

**Meals:** Breakfast, dinner

**Accommodation:** Guilin Bravo Hotel, Standard Twin Room

Transportation to the airport (Xian) for your flight to Guilin. After arrival you will be met and transferred to the hotel.

### Guilin - Yangshuo

**Transfer via:** Boat

**Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch

**Accommodation:** Green Lotus Hotel, River View Room

Li River cruise from Guilin to Yangshuo. Countryside tour for about 1.5-2 hours for a round trip by cycling or private vehicle

**Accommodation:** The Royal Pacific Hotel and Towers, Premier Room at hotel wing Drive from Longji to Guilin. Transfer to the train station and take a train to Hong Kong.
